WELCOME TO THE 2018 PARISH MEETING

YOUR COUNCILLORS HAVE MET SIX TIMES IN THE PAST YEAR AND CONDUCTED A CONSIDERABLE AMOUNT OF BUSINESS ON BEHALF OF THE VILLAGE

THE MOST CONTENTIOUS MATTERS HAVE BEEN CONCERNING PLANNING APPLICATIONS UNFORTUNATELY OUR OBJECTIONS HAVE NOT BEEN SUCCESSFUL IN STOPPING THE GRANTING OF PLANNING PERMISSION

WE WELCOMED OUR NEW COUNCILLOR PAT BOSANQUET AND KAY ROTHERY HAS TAKEN THE POSITION OF VICE CHAIRMAN OF THE PARISH COUNCIL

WE APPROVED THE PLANTING OF A TREE IN MEMORY OF ANITA GREENFIELD

WE HAVE TRIED TO RESOLVE THE PROBLEMS WITH THE HORSE RIDERS BUT NORTH LINGS COUNCIL WERE AGAINST THE ERECTION OF ANY MORE ROAD SIGNS

HOWEVER THE NEW 30MPH RESTRICTIONS HAVE BEEN PLACED ON BARTON ROAD AND THE A18

WE ARE ALSO TRYING TO GET SOME OF THE MOST SERIOUS POTHOLES REPAIRED A LARGE CROWD GATHERED TO WATCH THE TOUR OF BRITAIN CYCLE RACE AND CONSIDERABLE EFFORTS WERE MADE TO DECORATE THE ROUTE THROUGH THE VILLAGE

WE DIDN'T WIN THE BEST KEPT VILLAGE COMPETITION BUT RECEIVED SATISFACTORY COMMENTS WE MUST THANK CHRIS AND KAY ROTHERY AND THEIR TEAM FOR THE PLANTING AND CARE OF THE VARIOUS BEDS IN THE VILLAGE WE HAVE RECEIVED A GRANT OF £694 FROM NORTH LINGS COUNCIL FOR PLANTS THIS SPRING

WE HAVE BEEN ABLE TO FUND THE REPAIRS TO THE FLOOR IN THE VILLAGE HALL ALSO WE HAVE REPLACED THE DIRECTION SIGNS AND PAINTED THE ENTRANCE DOORS THE FOOTBALL CHANGING ROOM AND STORAGE CONTAINER HAVE BEEN INSTALLED AND PAINTED

WE HAVE MADE A DONATION OF £100 TO THE LITTLE FREE LIBRARY SCHEME AT THE SCHOOL
